

**All issues require a YES or NO response**

**St. Louis County Proposition B:** Shall the Charter of St. Louis County be amended to provide for the regulation of fund transfers within a department, as set forth in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 27,145, on file with the St. Louis County Administrative Director and St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners?

*This measure would give the council authority to transfer money within the county budget without the approval of the county executive, and would require the county executive to get council approvals for transfers within a county department.*

**St. Louis County Proposition C:** Shall the Charter of St. Louis County be amended to provide for a website to publish certain county financial documents, as set forth in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 27,143, on file with the St. Louis County Administrative Director and St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners?

*This would require the county to establish a website for public access to financial documents.*

**St. Louis County Proposition D:** Shall there be a Charter Commission to revise and amend the Charter?

**St. Louis County Proposition F:** Shall the St. Louis County Charter be amended by providing for the authority of casinos licensed by the Missouri Gaming Commission to allow smoking on no more than fifty percent of the floor area on which gambling games are permitted?

**St. Louis County Proposition Z:** Shall St. Louis County impose a county-wide sales tax **of one-eighth of one percent** (.125%) for the purpose of providing funds for the management and care of animals and other zoological activities and zoological facilities of the *Saint Louis Zoological Park Subdistrict*, and with all moneys received to be deposited in the treasury of St. Louis County (minus any statutory costs of collection) to the credit of the Saint Louis Zoological Park Subdistrict and kept separate and apart from other moneys of St. Louis County, with the Saint Louis Zoological Park Subdistrict Commission to have the exclusive control of the expenditure of all moneys collected to the credit of the Saint Louis Zoological Park Subdistrict?

**St. Louis County Proposition 1:** Shall the Charter of St. Louis County be amended to provide for the regulation of campaign finance contributions, as set forth in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 27,144, on file with the St. Louis County Administrative Director and St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners?

*This measure would put a \$2,600 per-election campaign limit on contributions by any individual or entity to a candidate for a county elected office, no candidate committee for a person who is a candidate shall accept a campaign contribution from any person or entity who is applying for any St. Louis County contract beginning 90 days before any request for submissions is issued and ending 90 days after to contract has been awarded. If any candidate committee accepts such a contribution, they shall be disqualified from entering into a contract with the county.*

**St. Louis County Proposition 2:** Shall the Charter of St. Louis County be amended by addition of a section requiring voter approval of certain land transactions concerning county parks, as set forth in Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 27,131 on file with the St. Louis County Administrative Director and St. Louis County Board of Election Commissioners?

*This measure would require a public vote before parkland is sold or used for commercial purposes.*
