### There's a lot at Stake in 2014 starting with the April Elections

Volunteers are hard at work on the April 2014 local elections Voters Guide again to be published with the Post-Dispatch and candidate forums. We are inviting over 900 candidates to provide good quality non-partisan information with voters. We have answered every request for candidate forums. There is so much at stake in local elections: the challenges facing school districts to provide quality education, decreased resources for our counties and municipalities responsible for providing essential services, and fair, competent, and transparent government right in our own back yards!

We are also following developments at the state level that impact the voting rights of Missouri citizens. We applaud the Secretary of State's implementation of on-line voter registration and his support of early voting. But we are appalled at the bills currently being considered that would result in one of the most restrictive Voter Photo I.D. laws in the country. We testified against this proposal and were amazed that proponents could not offer a single example of voter fraud in Missouri. Is it good government to make voting difficult for women, students, the elderly, disabled and minority populations who will find it difficult to obtain the documentation necessary to obtain the proposed official IDs? Is it good government to spend \$4-6 million on a problem that doesn't exist? Is it good government to put up barriers to voting? The League doesn't think so. We will continue to oppose this legislation and work to make voting accessible to all.

Petitions for state wide ballot issues are in full circulation. We'll keep track of them and be ready to educate the public come November. We'll keep the Metro News readers posted. It is going to be quite a year.
